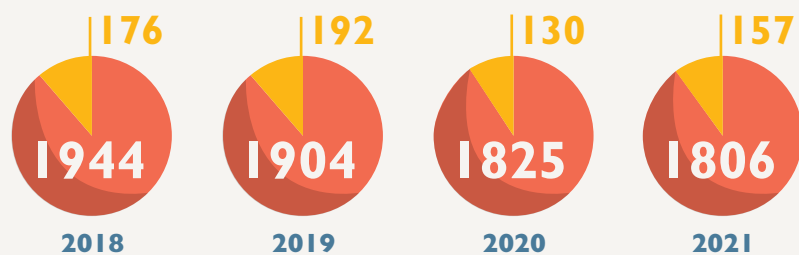

* **RECOLLIDA I RECICLATGE, SL**

Established in 1994, the Tac Osona Foundation has a 35% stake in its share capital. It is a company specialising in the collection of waste and recycling plastic, cardboard and pallets. Twenty-one people work there, of whom five have intellectual disabilities.

* **VIC VERD, SL**

Established in 2011, Sant Tomàs holds 42% of the share capital, Recollida i Reciclatge S.L. holds 9%, and Vic City Council 49%. It manages the gardening services for the municipality of Vic and the collection of junk. It employs thirteen people with intellectual disabilities and six others with mental disabilities or disorders.

* **ECOGRUP ECOLÒGICA, SL**

Established in 2012, the Tac Osona Foundation and the Viver de Bell-lloc Foundation hold 75% of the share capital in equal parts, and the remaining 25% is owned by private partners in the organic fruit and vegetable sector.

* **UTE TAC-MAP**

Established in 2016. The MAP Foundation and the Tac Osona Foundation have equal shareholdings. It provides gardening services in the municipality of Torelló.

* **TAC OSONA EMPRESA D'INSERCIÓ, SLU**

Established in 2021. Owned by the Tac Osona Foundation, and established with the support of Manlleu Municipal council. It specialises in the social and occupational integration in the cleaning and area maintenance sector of people who have difficulty finding work. It employs twenty-nine people at risk of social exclusion.

* **TAC OSONA SERVEIS, SLU**

Established in 2021. Owned by the Tac Osona Foundation, this is an organisational improvement and an important complement to the work done by the Special Work Centre. Services are provided by professionals from the various work areas of the Special Work Centre.

Joan Casany, new president of the institution

Joan Casany is the new president of Sant Tomàs, replacing Toni Ramírez who had been the organisation's president for the previous twelve years. Casany is a businessman and the brother of one of the first children who received care from the organisation. His priorities are the people cared for, their families, the professionals and making Sant Tomàs an even bigger organisation.



Donations from Aigües Vic for healthy habits

Aigües Vic made several donations to the Tac Osona Foundation for the friendly environment project for people with Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD) and to promote healthy habits among Tac workers. This is a very valuable contribution for improving the opportunities and well-being of the people who work at the Sant Tomàs Special Employment Centre.



Sant Tomàs helps with Vic's adapted race

A family at the Estel school organised the first adapted children's race in Vic with the help of Sant Tomàs. About fifty children between the ages of 3 and 12 years old took part in this event, and took home a bag with gifts including a Sant Tomàs chocolate lollipop created especially for the occasion.

The training lasted 10 hours, and was organised in 5 sessions.



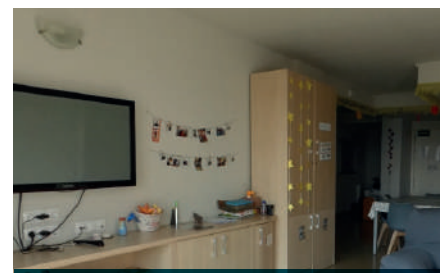
Sant Tomàs hosts 8 European volunteers

Eight volunteers from the European Solidarity Corps programme joined the organisation's different services to work with and contribute multicultural knowledge that is "enriching for the people cared for and the workers." They come from Germany, the Czech Republic, Finland, Portugal and Holland, and they will be doing voluntary work at Eina, at l'Estel, at the various occupational centres and at the CAR Club until September 2022.



The advent calendar - among the 20 best in the world

The Californian media group TasteTV listed the Sant Tomàs chocolate workshop's advent calendar as one of the top twenty in the world in terms of creativity and craftsmanship. This post ranked all the advent calendars that were posted on Instagram.



The waiting list for access to housing grows

There are 83 people in Osona on the waiting list for access to a housing resource for people with intellectual disabilities. This figure is an increase compared to the previous year. Sant Tomàs took part in the International Day for Disability, which this year called for a reduction in the waiting lists for access to a place in sheltered accommodation or in a residential home.



18 people recruited by Eina in 2021

The training and job placement service Eina ended the year 2021 with 18 new recruits. At the end of 2021, there were 120 people employed in ordinary companies through Eina, and 78% of them have a permanent contract.



Sant Hipòlit has an Occupational Centre

The former retirement home of Sant Hipòlit has become the offices of the Occupational Centre that has been opened in the town. The facility currently works with eight people from Voltreganès and the surrounding area. The facility's proximity to their homes and to the community environment fosters inclusion in the surrounding area.



Tac Osona Empresa d'Inserció S.L.U. is established.

Tac Osona founds a work placement company in partnership with Manlleu Municipal council, which has employed 29 people in the cleaning sector in one year. This new institution specialises in the social and occupational integration of people who have been unemployed for many years.



T'Acompanyem group provides training in NLP

The group of families and professionals from the T'Acompanyem group have started a training workshop in Neurolinguistic Programming (NLP). The T'Acompanyem programme is made up of relatives of people with intellectual disabilities who voluntarily provide occasional support to other families who want to share their experience.



The school Estel has a new van

The school Estel has a new van thanks to a donation from the La Caixa Foundation which has made it possible to purchase a new 9-seater vehicle. This vehicle means all the students can be transported on outings, and provides a complement to bus transport for excursions and summer camps.



Sant Tomàs presents its new code of ethics

The team at the Sant Tomàs facility for reflection on ethics in social intervention services (ERESS) has drawn up the new code of ethics which is a "defining instrument of the institution". This instrument provides guidance for the participants when they are faced with dilemmas or situations that create ethical conflicts. It is available for consultation on the website or in paper format at the various services where there are also easy-to-read editions.



The first course on autism - a complete success

The Espai Viu centre has taught the first course on "Discovering autism: from understanding to inclusion" recognised by the Catalan Ministry of Education. The attendees rated the course very positively, and a second edition of the same course will be available for all those who were unable to attend.

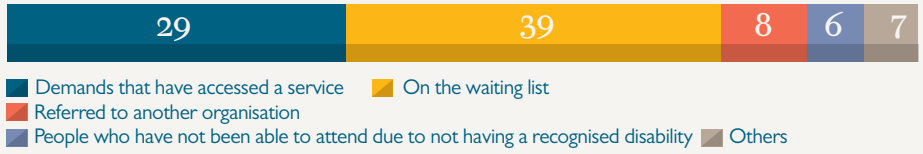
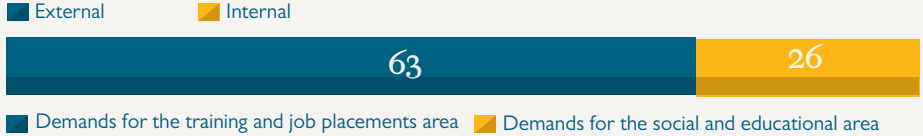

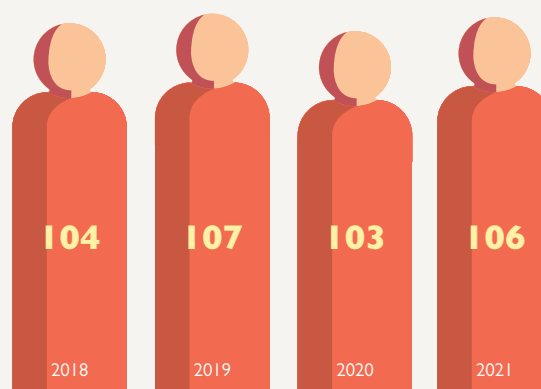

Eina training and job placement centre

This centre provides overall care through job training and providing the necessary support for both the individual and the company during the job placement process. It also monitors the employment of people who have been recruited to ensure their job stability and effective coordination with the contracting party.

Tac Osona Social enterprise

The Tac Osona Special Work Centre is a social enterprise where more than 70% of the workers are people with intellectual disabilities. They work with the support of monitors at their workplace. Psychologists and social workers provide comprehensive support for the person and their family which apart from the job placement itself, contributes to their full social inclusion.

FAMILY SATISFACTION SURVEYS

The second overall satisfaction survey of Sant Tomàs families was carried out in 2021 in order to determine their level of satisfaction with each of the services. The first was carried out in 2019 in order to determine the families' opinions of the organisation and the care their relatives received.

The surveys are a basic tool for Sant Tomàs to improve care based on the families' assessments of the institution. With the data in hand, the results encourage us to continue working to improve the quality of life of the people we serve and their families.

- ❖ Participation increased compared to 2019 as despite the percentage being similar (60%), the sample grew by more than 130 families. 648 responses were received from a sample of 1,086 families, while in 2019 there were 564 responses from a sample of 948 families.

- ❖ 93% of those surveyed said that their relative enjoys a better quality of life thanks to Sant Tomàs, the result of the total of the "Very much" and "a lot" answers. The figures show that the families consider that the organisation's work is in line with its mission.

- ❖ The degree of satisfaction with Sant Tomàs increased by 3 points compared to 2019, the result of the total of the "Very much" and "a lot" answers, and satisfaction with the service has increased by more than 7 points if the same answers are added together.

- ❖ Having a clear contact professional in the services provided means that families know who to turn to at all times and who to deal with for support. 95% of the families can identify and know who to ask about their relative.

- ❖ The survey results were returned in more detail to the families through the usual communication channels and are available for consultation on the institution's website.

- ❖ The results of the surveys allow the teams in the various services to work on improvement plans for the people they work with and their families.

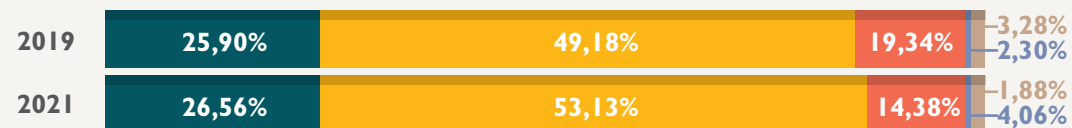

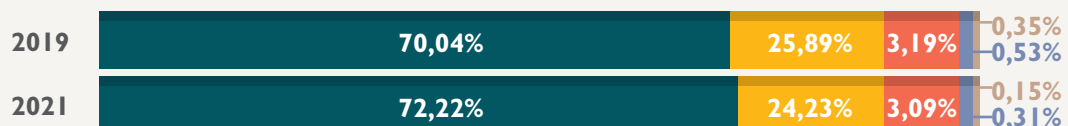
To what extent does Saint Thomas help you to have peace of mind and trust in the future?



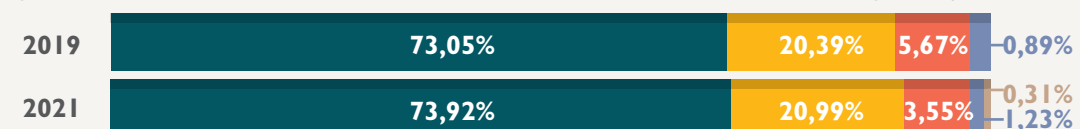
Rate the extent to which the participation of families in Sant Tomàs is enhanced



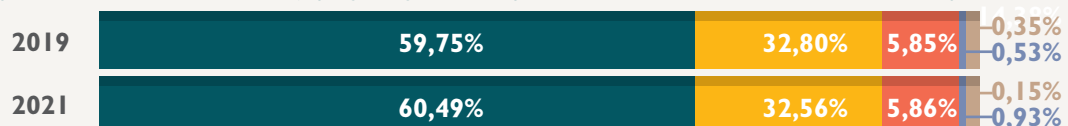

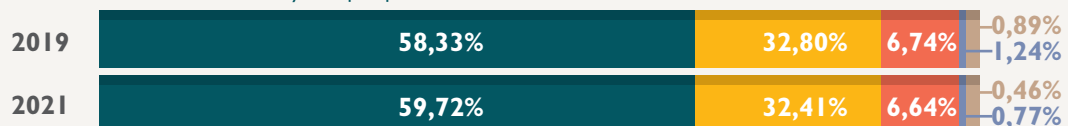

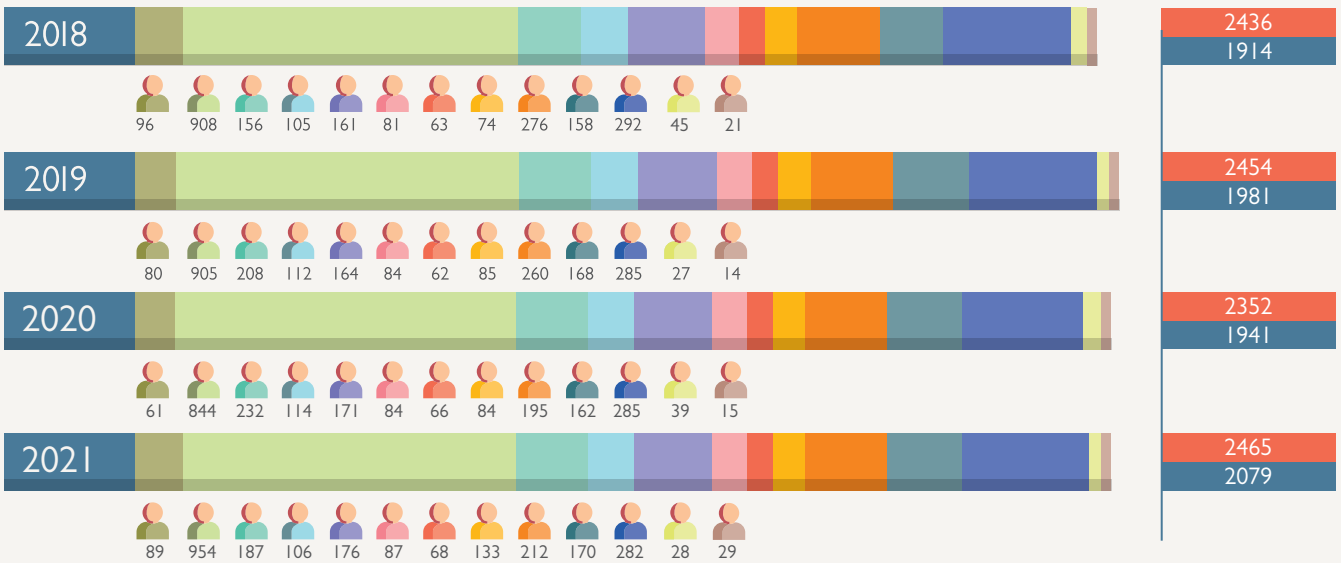

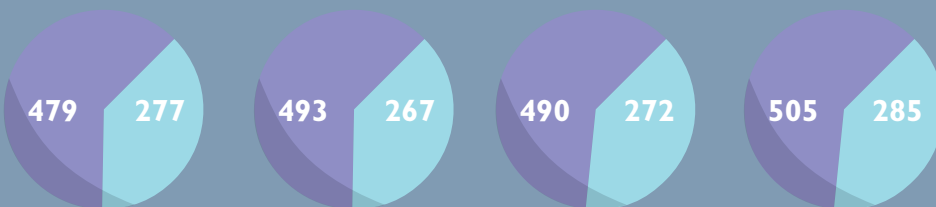

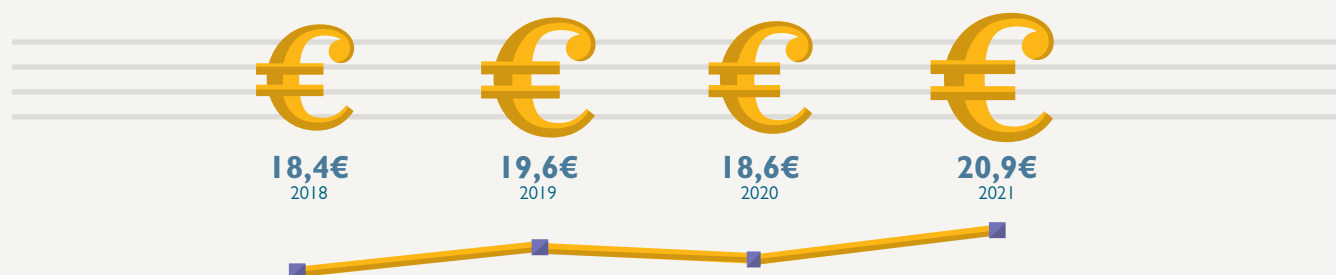

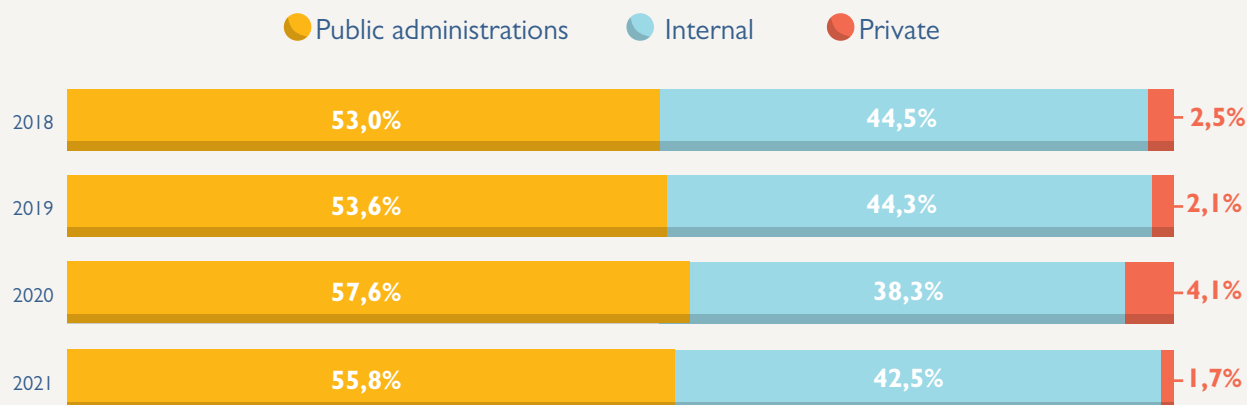

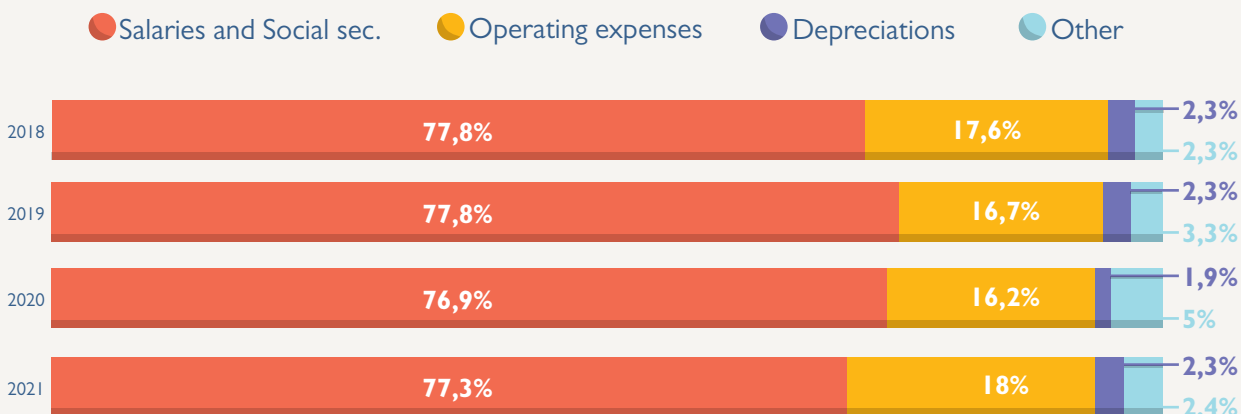
